Top Tips For Relevant Content

- Use Facebook and other social media to find stories and bounce ideas – make friends and ASK your Alumni
- Use ‘surveys’ to make getting stories easy (hopefully integrated into TT soon)
- Use ‘Clubs’ on your TT site to create mini communities within your wider community e.g. University Buddy Clubs, City Networking Clubs
- Ask Ask Ask...even if you don't need to ask – ASK your community to get involved
- Make it easy for them to open your emails – make them relevant to the people you are sending e.g. Catch up with a friend from 1988-1990 (sent to people in the school that time)





[redacted] Hm... I'm not sure about rentals but can try answering with what I know...for accommodation within 2-4 MRT stations from Telok Ayer, there are a few apartments there, one of which is very popular among expats - The Sail at Marina Bay but I'm guessing rental rates there will be pretty steep.

Tanjong Rhu is really near Telok Ayer -15 min drive or even less than that. If you don't mind changing MRT lines, there are places like Dakota, Paya Lebar, Mountbatten, Aljunied, Kallang, Marine Parade in the east that have good accommodation near amenities like shopping centres, libraries, sports/swimming complexes, that are within the Periphery of the circle line (yellow line of the MRT). Driving to the CBD from those places is also around 15 mins as it's a direct expressway (East-Coast Park expressway) to Telok Ayer. (Can take a look at Singapore's MRT train map so you can see the stations) 3 years ago

Sorry to push this a little bit, but your information has prompted us to start looking at accommodation areas. We realised we are actually looking for close to CBD, as my partner will work long hours in Telok Ayer. The budget we have should be slightly lower than 2,700 SGD per month and we hope to get a studio apartment or a cheap one bedroom. Do any of you possibly know what are nice areas that are between 2-4 stops away from Telok Ayer at all so that we can start looking there first? :D Thank you so much again! 3 years ago

Dear Ri Xin and David, that is very insightful and useful information. I shall look into Mediacorp and Work Holiday Passes as soon as possible. Thank you so much for all the help. This is working great! xx 3 years ago

I, a recent Cambridge graduate can consider the Work Holiday Pass (which is relatively little-known, even to Singaporean employers, but will give you six months to live, work, and look for work visa-free). Otherwise a lot depends on whether you are formally married to your partner and his status in Singapore. If you are married, and your spouse is in the Employment Pass tier of work, then he can sponsor a Dependent's Pass for you. It is generally much better to have a job in hand (Work Holiday Pass excepting). You should seek to sort out your status well in advance of 2017. 3 years ago

6. Emirates is highly recommended by many.



their Time, Talent & Treasure

Encouraging Time & Talent

- Invite Alumni to come and speak with students or show their craft/job to them
- Encourage Alumni to become mentors AND seek help from the network
- It's not just about giving their time and talent to your school – its about them sharing with each other too

Encouraging Small Treasure

- Do you have an emblem? E.g. a scarf or a teddy or a flag? Encourage Alumni to fly the flag and send in photos
- Purchase a cute Teddy and give it away free for a £100 donation – people like to feel they are getting something back
- When they visit pay for their taxi back to the station (if they arrive by Taxi and say ‘the taxi is on us but if you would like to give a small donation to the foundation’ and then give them a card with the details)
- Sell tickets to events and say the money is a donation
- Use companies like TheGivingMachine – simple way to raise money via internet shopping.
- Payroll Giving – if you are a charity advertise this to current staff and alumni so they can make a donation through their current employer if their company is UK based
- Donations during Events – encourage more donations at events e.g. anonymous envelopes on table with free bottle champagne for table that raises the most?
- Once you have lots of members, encourage competition between year groups e.g. 1998 leavers were collectively Donors of the Year (never disclose amounts)
- Get old school photos scanned and sell them at a profit in your shop

Encouraging Large Treasure



- Do you have a Founder Donor Wall – raised 2018 £350,000
- Leaver Student Pot Give Back – raised 2018 £XXX
- Have an ‘Ever Growing Donor Wall’ celebrating larger donation over £500 £1k? £5k?
- Build a Business Case for Donations – how much do we actually need for a full Endowment Scholarship fund for 2 or 4 or 6 students per year. Business people respond better to business facts and figures
- Look at a Legacy Giving policy
- Recruit Ambassadors around the World – Stewarding identified wealthy Alumni
- Look into USA Giving – Aged 70.5 Tax Break. We have over 70 USA Alumni
